

CLUE NUMBER ONE

This first clue will help show you around your simplified Constitution (you're welcome for not giving you the real version). To find your simplified Constitution, look near where we can reduce our environmental impact #SaveTheTurtles. As you read through this information, I'd recommend looking at your print off of the Constitution and/or making some notes to help you later.

1. Article 1- This article is all about Congress aka the Legislative Branch aka the House of Representatives and the Senate.
2. Article 2- This article is all about the President aka the Executive Branch.
3. Article 3- This article is all about the Judicial Branch aka the Supreme Court aka federal judges.
4. Article 4- This article is all about states' rights, what they can and cannot do.
5. Article 5- This article is about how the Constitution can be changed.
6. Article 6- This article isn't that important (at least to this activity).
7. Article 7- This article is just saying how 13 states ratified the Constitution.
8. Bill of Rights- These are the first 10 amendments (or additions) to the Constitution. These are discussing our rights as citizens. If it has to do with the government doing something unfair to us/the citizens, I'd start looking here.
9. The rest of the amendments- So basically, this is all the stuff that they forgot and had to add later. It's really random, so I highly recommend you've at least skimmed/looked for big ideas so if you hear something like "abolish slavery" you'll remember that it's at least in this section.

Test your knowledge to get the code for clue #2. Use the numbers for the next password.

- Where would you look for information on what the President can/cannot do?
- Where would you find something about the President that ISN'T in the same # you just said.
- Where would you find the information about your rights as a citizen?
